Selectmen's Meeting
January 10, 2022**

Call to order at 7:04- Chair Dick Deans presided. Elizabeth Olsen, Curtis Smith, and members of the public were present.

1. To approve the minutes of Dec 27, 2021:

- GWI needs to have an inventory of all the poles, owners, roads and what there is for wires in the town. David Tatro from GWI sent an invite to attend a zoom meeting to explain this inventory process and what we need to get it done. Town should get some volunteers , 5 teams of 2 to complete the task .Beth says there is approx.. 25 poles per mile The zoom meeting is January 13 at 1:30 all agreed to look for volunteers and attend the zoom meeting.
