They are very interested in purchasing the property for back taxes plus and fees associated with the purchase. Maine Revenue has a lien on the property. The selectmen reviewed the foreclosure documents and offered it to these interested abutters to have first refusal. The Quit Claim deed process was explained. The Gauthier's accepted the price of back taxes plus 10%. Dick will get the deed drawn up and call them when it is ready.

**Audit**: Dick received a letter to put in the Town Report. The Audit Draft should be available at the Town Meeting.

**Abatement:** Abatement on Acreage on Lane Road belonging to the Janet Smith Trust – The split was not properly apportioned, and the over assessed acreage was abated by the Board of Assessors.

A proposal from Spectrum for an entire build for the cost of 140,000 was reviewed. It was agreed to send the agreement to legal for review prior to signing.
