1. To approve the minutes of Sept 27, 2021: Motion to approve the minutes of Sept. 27, 2021, by Curtis Smith, seconded by Dick Deans. Approved 3-0.

3. Ball Field Parking Lot Use.

- Zack, the new owner of Storekeepers, came to propose using the parking area for a Trunk-ortreat function on Halloween from 4 – 5:30 pm. Members of the community will be asked to participate. He will also check with the school to see if weekend and holiday parking would be available for his guests, alleviating the extra vehicles from the lot. Zack offered to look at his land to see if there is enough room for Alex's business to park. They will be meeting to discuss. Alex requested a new multi-use sign be erected to replace the one that was torn down. Dick Deans will order one.
