Call to order at 7:00 - Chair Dick Deans presided. Elizabeth Olsen and Curtis Smith were present.

1. To approve the minutes of Nov. 22, 2021:

Motion to approve the minutes of Nov 22, 2021 by Curtis Smith, seconded by Beth Olsen. Approved 3-0.

2. Public Comment: No visitors were present.

3. Hebron Historical:

Bob Swift was present to discuss the Railroad building and the possibility of leaving it where it is and fixing it up. He mentioned all the difficulty they have had in getting someone to move it and the cost. Beth mentioned there were some grants available for doing repairs to old buildings and she would ask her mother about possibly help in writing a grant. It was decided to keep it where it is and they will continue to make repairs.

4. Roads:

Bob Swift commented on the increased traffic on the Center Road and wondered if the Lane road was on the list to be paved at some point. Dick said it would need some extensive reconstruction before it could be paved also that DEP had suggested some work to be done in the ledge area.

Kevin Bryant on the Sodom Road called and thought the road was not getting plowed the way other roads in town are. Dick told him when the board meets and he should attend to voice his concerns. Unpaved town roads are taken care of by the highway dept. in the same manner as the other roads in town.

5. Broadband Grant: Hebron along with Hartford and Sumner were each awarded a \$4000.Start up Grant and discussion was around how to use these funds, it was suggested to get the broadband committee active again to get their input in these funds and to get someone on the committee to be the point person. There also needs to be a list of town road names, mileage on each and number of residence on each road. Dick will check with Jim Trundy for an0 up to date list. Beth motioned and Curtis seconded to accept the \$4000.grant money.
