## 5. Roads:

 Discussed the Holiday pay when the crew must plow on the Holiday. Christmas holiday was taken as a day off on Friday December 24<sup>th</sup>, they worked plowing on the 25<sup>th</sup>. Since they were paid for the holiday already, December 25<sup>th</sup> they would receive straight pay ( or time and a half if overtime.)

## 6. Selectmen's Business:

- Dick Deans reported that Fire Chief Jim Trundy would be taking the pickup truck RFP to several local dealers.
- The Board discussed an annual raise for the staff. Social Security is giving 5.9% and the County is giving 3%. Discussion on the level other municipalities paid and the importance of keeping staff.
