

Town of Hebron RFP Paving

The Town of Hebron is seeking sealed bids for paving Allen Road and Bryant Road. The jobs consist of a $\frac{3}{4}$ "shim with a $1\frac{1}{2}$ " overlay using a 9.5 mm shim and 9.5 mm overlay. Scope of work and bid documents are available at the Hebron Town Office and on the town website at www.Hebronmaine.org.

The Town reserves the right to accept or reject any and all bids, in whole or in part.

INSTRUCTION TO BIDDERS

- 1. All bids must be sealed, clearly marked " Road Bid" and filed with the Town Clerk on the attached bid proposal form at the Hebron Town Office by 4:00 p.m., Monday, April 24, 2023. Bids received after that time *will not* be considered.**

- 2. Bids will be opened and read aloud at 6:00 p.m., Monday, April 24, 2023. After consideration of all bids, and within 7 days after the bids are opened, the Municipal Officers shall announce their decision. The Municipal Officers will be the sole judge of the acceptability of the bids and may reject any or all bids if it is judged to be in the Town's best interest. The contract shall be awarded to the lowest responsive, responsible bidder unless the Municipal Officers exercise their right to reject any or all bids.**

- 3. It is the responsibility of the prospective bidder to inspect the construction site and examine the specifications to ensure that he/she fully understands the work requirements. Any questions regarding the work should be directed to Highway Foreman at least twenty-four hours before bid opening.**

- 4. Any errors or omissions detected by prospective bidders should be brought to the attention of the Town at least twenty-four hours before bid opening.**

- 5. A pre-bid conference with the Road Forman, Robert Downey is mandatory. He can be contacted at 207-754-3202.**

TOWN OF HEBRON ROAD SPECIFICATIONS

The project involves work on the ALLEN ROAD as follows:

The project consists of a length of Allen Road measured from the intersection of Rt. 124 to the Hebron Town Line.

The second Project consists of the full length of Bryant Road from the intersection of Townsend Road to Route 124.

Providing butt joints at the start and end of paving and also at any intersection of any paved public or private road included in the bid total.

Provide all necessary engineering, centerline, and layout for the project at no cost to the town.

Sweeping of the entire road section must be included in the bid price.

Tack must be included in this proposal on existing pavement and between layers.

Furnish and apply a 3/4" average finish depth shim of 9.5 mm pavement.

Furnish and apply a 1 1/2" finish depth overlay of 9.5 mm pavement, and feather all existing driveways.

The project must be completed before October 15, 2023.

The contractor is required to have liability insurance. If more than one person is employed on this contract, the contractor is required to have worker's compensation. Copies of these insurance policies must be filed with the Bid.

The contractor will be responsible for traffic control during the performance of the work and shall comply with the manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices rules and regulations that apply.

The contractor will be responsible for OSHA regulations during the performance of the work and will hold the town harmless for any violation that may occur during construction.

The Town reserves the right to reject any and all bids. The Town of Hebron reserves the right to waive any informalities in the bid form. Although price shall be a consideration, the Town will consider aspects such as value and the ability to carry out the work within the time, in making its decision.

The project will be subject to inspection and approval by the Road Foreman.

A pre-bid conference with the Road Foreman, Robert Downey, is mandatory.
