Selectboard Meeting

May 28, 2024 Minutes

1. CALL TO ORDER AND FLAG SALUTE – Chairman Gino Valeriani presided. Selectmen Elizabeth Olsen and Derek Pike, Deputy Clerk Terri Grover, and Glen Holmes from Lake Auburn Watershed were present.
2. ACTION ON MINUTES
 - 2.1 Elizabeth motioned to accept minutes as written, Derek seconded, 3-0.
3. ADJUSTMENT TO AGENDA – None
4. PUBLIC COMMENTS – NONE
5. BUSINESS ITEMS
 - 5.1 Glen Holmes came to provide an update on the Lake Auburn Watershed – the Auburn Water District Authority are not able to enact ordinances outside the territorial limits of the City of Auburn per Eaton Peabody, Attorneys at Law. Per Glen the next step would be a lot map for each town, Hebron, Buckfield, and Minot showing if there were any properties directly impacting the watershed. He will not be anticipate continuing on the Board after March 2025 so would like to meet with the Chairmen from Hebron, Minot and Buckfield in the fall to see if there is any interest for a replacement.

 - 5.3 Signed Lien discharge for Douglass (with corrected margins)
 - 5.4 Signed County Tax Warrant with discussion on impact on tax rate for residents. Elizabeth motioned to sign, Gino seconded, 3-0.
 - 5.5 Salt Bid tabled until next meeting.
 - 5.6 Discussion of School District Budget and the effect on mil rate. This budget is being questioned by other towns as well. Discussion and a decision to post on the Town's website, Facebook page and our resident e mail list a statement asking all residents review the budget and make an informed decision prior to voting.
6. Chairman's Items – Discussion of Financial Officer Position – Reviewed the ad and job description Elizabeth had drafted. Suggested to add benefits to ad. This will be posted on the Website, on MMA's website, and on Indeed.
7. Selectmen's Items – A request to close the Town Office on Friday July 5th if the employees were willing to use a vacation day. As it only impacts 2 employees and residents can re-

register cars and boats on line, and posting in advance for residents to be aware it was decided to approve. Elizabeth motioned, Gino seconded, 3-0.
